23 The amount hereinabove for Storm Damage Relief shall be allocated by the Commissioner of
24 the Department of Community Affairs among the following municipalities: Bordentown
25 City, Bordentown Township, Chesterfield Township, Wrightstown Boro, Easthampton
26 Township, Fieldsboro Boro, Florence Township, Mansfield Township, New Hanover
27 Township, North Hanover Township, Pemberton Boro, Pemberton Township and
28 Springfield Township.

35 This supplemental appropriation provides \$250,000 in storm
36 damage relief to the municipalities of Bordentown City, Bordentown
