1 A SUPPLEMENT to "An Act making appropriations for the support of
2 the State Government and the several public purposes for the fiscal
3 year ending June 30, 1997 and regulating the disbursement
4 thereof," approved June 28, 1996 (P.L.1996, c.42).

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6 BE IT ENACTED by the Senate and General Assembly of the State
7 of New Jersey:

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9 1. In addition to the amounts appropriated under P.L.1996, c.42,
10 there is appropriated out of the General Fund the following sum for
11 the purpose specified:

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23 2. This act shall take effect on October 1, 1996.

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26 STATEMENT

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28 The amount of available federal Social Services Block Grant funds
29 will be reduced by approximately \$9.2 million on October 1, 1996. This
30 reduction will affect various social services programs funded by the
31 county welfare agencies, the Division of Youth and Family Services, and
32 the Departments of Community Affairs, Corrections and Health and
33 Senior Services.

34 This bill appropriates \$9,200,000 from the General Fund to the
35 Department of Human Services to offset this reduction in federal Social
36 Services Block Grant funding and to prevent social services programs
37 from being reduced or terminated effective October 1, 1996.
