1 AN ACT concerning the Delaware River and Bay Authority and
2 authorizing certain projects.

4 **BE IT ENACTED** by the Senate and General Assembly of the State
5 of New Jersey:

7 1. For the purposes of complying with the provisions of section 1
8 of P.L.1989, c.191 (C.32:11E-1.1) the Delaware River and Bay
9 Authority created pursuant to the "Delaware-New Jersey Compact,"
10 enacted pursuant to 53 Laws of Delaware, Chapter 145 (17 Del.
11 C.1701 et seq.) and P.L.1961, c.66 (C.32:11E-1 et seq.) with the
12 consent of the Congress of the United States in accordance with
13 Pub.L.87-678 (1962), is authorized, pursuant to the procedures set
14 forth in section 1 of P.L.1989, c.191 (C.32:11E-1.1), and pursuant to
15 an agreement entered into between the City of Millville, Cumberland
16 County, and the authority, to undertake a project to lease the property
17 and manage the operations of the Millville Airport Utility, located in
18 the City of Millville, Cumberland County, from the City of Millville,
19 which shall be considered a project of the authority as defined
20 pursuant to Article II of the "Delaware-New Jersey Compact,"
21 P.L.1961, c.66, as amended by P.L.1989, c.192 (C.32:11E-1 et seq.),
22 which project shall continue to maintain airport operations in that
23 location.

25 2. This act shall take effect immediately.

STATEMENT

29

30 This bill would provide legislative authorization and approval for
31 the Delaware River and Bay Authority to lease the property of and
32 operate the Millville Airport Utility in the City of Millville,
33 Cumberland County. This bill would require that the project
34 authorized by this bill continue to maintain airport operations in the

1 location referred to in the bill.

2 Under the provisions of the "Delaware-New Jersey Compact," the
3 Delaware River and Bay Authority is permitted to plan, finance,
4 develop, construct, purchase, lease, maintain, improve and operate a
5 "transportation or terminal facility" in Delaware or the New Jersey
6 counties of Cape May, Cumberland, Gloucester and Salem "for the
7 sound economic development" of that area. However, such project
8 cannot be undertaken by the authority without first holding a public
9 hearing and having secured legislative authorization and approval of
10 that project, or part thereof, pursuant to New Jersey law. This bill
11 would provide for such authorization provided that a contract is
12 entered into between the authority and the City of Millville.
