1 AN ACT appropriating <sup>1</sup>[\$375,000] \$450,000<sup>1</sup> from the "Port of New  
2 Jersey Revitalization, Dredging, Environmental Cleanup, Lake  
3 Restoration, and Delaware Bay Area Economic Development Bond  
4 Act of 1996," P.L.1996, c.70, for lake restoration projects in  
5 Monmouth county.

7 **BE IT ENACTED** by the Senate and General Assembly of the State  
8 of New Jersey:

10 1. a. There is appropriated to the Department of Environmental  
11 Protection from the "1996 Lake Restoration Fund," established  
12 pursuant to section 21 of the "Port of New Jersey Revitalization,  
13 Dredging, Environmental Cleanup, Lake Restoration, and Delaware  
14 Bay Area Economic Development Bond Act of 1996," P.L.1996,  
15 c.70," the sum of <sup>1</sup>[\$375,000] \$450,000<sup>1</sup> for the purpose of providing  
16 a grant to Monmouth county to meet the cost of lake restoration  
17 projects listed in subsection b. of this section.

18 b. The following lake restoration projects in Monmouth county  
19 shall be funded with the monies appropriated pursuant to subsection  
20 a. of this section:

17 c. Any unexpended funds from the projects listed in subsection b.  
18 of this section shall be returned to the "1996 Lake Restoration Fund"  
19 for reappropriation to fund additional projects authorized by law.

20 d. Any transfer of any funds or project sponsor, or change in  
21 project site, listed in subsection b. of this section shall require the  
22 approval of the Joint Budget Oversight Committee or its successor.

24 2. The expenditures of sums appropriated by this act are subject to  
25 the provisions and conditions of P.L.1996, c.70.

27 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
