1 AN ACT appropriating funds from the "Correctional Facilities
2 Construction Fund of 1987" to the Department of Corrections for
3 the renovation of certain correctional facilities.

5 BE IT ENACTED by the Senate and General Assembly of the State
6 of New Jersey:

8 1. There is appropriated to the Department of Corrections from
9 the "Correctional Facilities Construction Fund of 1987" created
10 pursuant to the "Correctional Facilities Construction Bond Act of
11 1987," P.L.1987, c.178, the sum of ¹[\$7,070,832] \$10,470,832¹ for
12 the following renovation projects:

1 expense incurred by the issuing officials under P.L.1987, c.178 for
2 advertising, engraving, printing, clerical, legal or other services
3 necessary to carry out the duties imposed upon them by the provisions
4 of that act.

6 3. In order to provide flexibility in administering the provisions of
7 this act, the Commissioner of the Department of Corrections may
8 apply to the Director of the Division of Budget and Accounting in the
9 Department of the Treasury for permission to transfer a part of any
10 item to any other item within the respective department accounts in the
11 "Correctional Facilities Construction Fund" account. The transfers
12 shall be made in a manner consistent with section 29 of P.L.1987,
13 c.178.

15 4. This act shall take effect immediately.
