P.L. 1997, CHAPTER 106, *approved June 2, 1997*  
Assembly, No. 362

1           **AN ACT** appropriating from the "Green Acres, Clean Water, Farmland  
2           and Historic Preservation Bond Act of 1992," P.L.1992, c.88, the  
3           sum of \$6,334,437 for the purpose of making grants, as awarded by  
4           the New Jersey Historic Trust, for certain historic preservation  
5           projects in southern New Jersey, and the sum of \$102,500 for the  
6           purpose of funding the monitoring and enforcement of historic  
7           preservation easements, restrictions, or other requirements.  
8

9           **BE IT ENACTED** by the Senate and General Assembly of the State  
10          of New Jersey:

12           1. a. There is appropriated to the New Jersey Historic Trust from  
13          the "1992 Historic Preservation Fund" established pursuant to section  
14          25 of the "Green Acres, Clean Water, Farmland and Historic  
15          Preservation Bond Act of 1992," P.L.1992, c.88, the sum of  
16          \$6,334,437 for the purpose of making grants, as awarded by the New  
17          Jersey Historic Trust, for historic preservation projects listed in this  
18          subsection. The sum appropriated pursuant to this subsection shall  
19          include administrative costs of the New Jersey Historic Trust incurred  
20          in administering this act. The following projects are eligible for  
21          funding with the monies appropriated pursuant to this subsection:

26 b. Any transfer of any funds or project sponsor listed in subsection  
27 a. of this section shall require the approval of the Joint Budget  
28 Oversight Committee or its successor.

29 c. There is appropriated to the New Jersey Historic Trust from the  
30 "1992 Historic Preservation Fund" established pursuant to section 25  
31 of the "Green Acres, Clean Water, Farmland and Historic Preservation  
32 Bond Act of 1992," P.L.1992, c.88, the sum of \$102,500 for the  
33 purpose of funding the monitoring and enforcement of historic  
34 preservation easements, restrictions, or other requirements associated

1 with the projects funded pursuant to subsection a. of this section and  
2 pursuant to P.L. , c. (now before the Legislature as Senate Bill  
3 No. of 1996 or Assembly Bill No. of 1996).  
4

5 2. To the extent that monies remain available after the projects  
6 listed in section 1 of this act are offered funding from the "1992  
7 Historic Preservation Fund," the projects listed in P.L. , c. (now  
8 before the Legislature as Senate Bill No. of 1996 or Assembly Bill  
9 No. of 1996) shall be eligible for funding, including administrative  
10 costs of the New Jersey Historic Trust in administering this section, in  
11 a sequence consistent with the priority system established by the New  
12 Jersey Historic Trust, and shall require the approval of the Joint  
13 Budget Oversight Committee or its successor.

15 3. The expenditure of the sums appropriated by this act is subject  
16 to the provisions and conditions of P.L.1992, c.88.  
17

18 4. This act shall take effect immediately.

#### 21 STATEMENT 22

23 This bill would appropriate to the New Jersey Historic Trust from  
24 the "1992 Historic Preservation Fund" established pursuant to section  
25 of the "Green Acres, Clean Water, Farmland and Historic  
26 Preservation Bond Act of 1992," P.L.1992, c.88, the sum of  
27 \$6,334,437 for the purpose of making grants, to be awarded by the  
28 New Jersey Historic Trust, for historic preservation projects in  
29 southern New Jersey, which sum would include administrative costs  
30 of the New Jersey Historic Trust incurred in administering the bill.  
31 The bill would also appropriate to the New Jersey Historic Trust from  
32 the "1992 Historic Preservation Fund" the sum of \$102,500 for the  
33 purpose of funding the monitoring and enforcement of historic  
34 preservation easements, restrictions, or other requirements associated  
35 with the projects funded pursuant to this bill and a companion bill for  
36 northern New Jersey (Senate Bill No. of 1996 or Assembly  
37 Bill No. of 1996).

39 The bill provides that any transfer of any funds or project sponsor  
40 listed in the bill would require the approval of the Joint Budget  
41 Oversight Committee or its successor.

42 The bill also provides that to the extent monies remain available  
43 after the projects listed in the bill are offered funding, the historic  
44 preservation projects listed in a companion bill for northern New  
45 Jersey (Senate Bill No. of 1996 or Assembly Bill No. of 1996)  
46 would be eligible for additional funding, including administrative costs,  
in a sequence consistent with the priority system established by the

1 New Jersey Historic Trust, but only with the approval of the Joint  
2 Budget Oversight Committee or its successor.
