1 **AN ACT** appropriating from the "Green Acres, Clean Water, Farmland
2 and Historic Preservation Bond Act of 1992," P.L.1992, c.88, the
3 sum of \$4,423,989 for the purpose of making grants, as awarded by
4 the New Jersey Historic Trust, for certain historic preservation
5 projects in northern New Jersey.

7 **BE IT ENACTED** *by the Senate and General Assembly of the State*
8 *of New Jersey:*

10 1. a. There is appropriated to the New Jersey Historic Trust from
11 the "1992 Historic Preservation Fund" established pursuant to section
12 25 of the "Green Acres, Clean Water, Farmland and Historic
13 Preservation Bond Act of 1992," P.L.1992, c.88, the sum of
14 \$4,423,989 for the purpose of making grants, as awarded by the New
15 Jersey Historic Trust, for historic preservation projects listed in this
16 subsection. The sum appropriated pursuant to this subsection shall
17 include administrative costs of the New Jersey Historic Trust incurred
18 in administering this act. The following projects are eligible for
19 funding with the monies appropriated pursuant to this subsection:

24 b. Any transfer of any funds or project sponsor listed in subsection
25 a. of this section shall require the approval of the Joint Budget
26 Oversight Committee or its successor.

28 2. To the extent that monies remain available after the projects
29 listed in section 1 of this act are offered funding from the "1992
30 Historic Preservation Fund," the projects listed in P.L. , c. (now
31 before the Legislature as Senate Bill No. of 1996 or Assembly
32 Bill No. of 1996) shall be eligible for funding, including
33 administrative costs of the New Jersey Historic Trust in administering
34 this section, in a sequence consistent with the priority system
35 established by the New Jersey Historic Trust, and shall require the
36 approval of the Joint Budget Oversight Committee or its successor.

1 3. The expenditure of the sums appropriated by this act is subject
2 to the provisions and conditions of P.L.1992, c.88.

This bill would appropriate to the New Jersey Historic Trust from
the "1992 Historic Preservation Fund" established pursuant to section
25 of the "Green Acres, Clean Water, Farmland and Historic
Preservation Bond Act of 1992," P.L.1992, c.88, the sum of
\$4,423,989 for the purpose of making grants, to be awarded by the
New Jersey Historic Trust, for historic preservation projects in
northern New Jersey, which sum would include administrative costs of
the New Jersey Historic Trust incurred in administering the bill.
