1 AN ACT reappropriating \$8,036,000 from the "Cultural Centers and  
2 Historic Preservation Fund," established pursuant to the "New  
3 Jersey Green Acres, Cultural Centers and Historic Preservation  
4 Bond Act of 1987," P.L.1987, c.265, to assist projects for cultural  
5 center development, and providing for cancellation of certain  
6 previous appropriations from the fund.

7  
8 **BE IT ENACTED** by the Senate and General Assembly of the State  
9 of New Jersey:

10  
11 1. a. There is reappropriated \$8,036,000 to the State Council on  
12 the Arts in the Department of State for the purpose of awarding grants  
13 to assist projects for cultural center development, which sum shall  
14 include administrative costs <sup>1</sup>of the projects<sup>1</sup>, from the unexpended  
15 balances of amounts previously appropriated pursuant to P.L.1989,  
16 c.349, P.L.1991, c.251 and P.L.1993, c.191 from the "Cultural  
17 Centers and Historic Preservation Fund," created pursuant to section  
18 20 of P.L.1987, c.265, to the extent the unexpended balances are  
19 available due to project cancellation or withdrawal or the inability to  
20 execute contract with grant applicant as of the effective date of P.L.,  
21 c. (C. ) (now pending before the Legislature as this bill), as  
22 determined by the State Council on the Arts. The following <sup>1</sup>capital<sup>1</sup>  
23 projects are eligible for funding from this reappropriation up to  
24 amounts listed herein and subject to grant awards:

26	The New Jersey Shakespeare Festival.....\$2,500,000
27	The John Harms <sup>1</sup> [Theater] <u>Concerts</u> <sup>1</sup> .....2,108,000
28	The Jersey City Museum.....2,000,000
29	Burlington County College.....530,000
30	The South Jersey Performing Arts Center.....500,000
31	Cumberland County College..... <u>398,000</u>
32	TOTAL.....\$8,036,000

1       b. Appropriations previously made pursuant to P.L.1989, c.349,  
2 P.L.1991, c.251 and P.L.1993, c.191 from the "Cultural Centers and  
3 Historic Preservation Fund," created pursuant to section 20 of  
4 P.L.1987, c.265, are hereby canceled to the extent of any unexpended  
5 balances in amounts in excess of the reappropriation made in  
6 subsection a. of this section that are available due to project  
7 cancellation or withdrawal or the inability to execute contract with  
8 grant applicant as of the effective date of P.L. , c. (C. )  
9 (now pending before the Legislature as this bill), as determined by the  
10 State Council on the Arts.

11       c. The State Council on the Arts shall report to the Joint Budget  
12 Oversight Committee within 30 days following the effective date of  
13 P.L. , c. (C. )(now pending before the Legislature as this  
14 bill) the <sup>1</sup>[amount of bond funds] amounts<sup>1</sup> previously appropriated  
15 pursuant to P.L.1989, c.349, P.L.1991, c.251 and P.L.1993, c.191 that  
16 remain unexpended as of the effective date of P.L. , c. (C. )  
17 (now pending before the Legislature as this bill) due to project  
18 cancellation, withdrawal or inability to execute contract with grant  
19 applicant and the reasons for any cancellation or withdrawal or  
20 inability to execute a contract.

21       d. The expenditure of the <sup>1</sup>[funds] sums<sup>1</sup> reappropriated by this  
22 section is subject to the provisions and conditions of P.L.1987, c.265.

24       2. This act shall take effect immediately.
