1 AN ACT concerning the sale of certain real property owned by the
2 Department of Military and Veterans' Affairs and repealing
3 P.L.1991, c.88.

5 **BE IT ENACTED** by the Senate and General Assembly of the State
6 of New Jersey:

8 ¹1. a. The Department of Military and Veterans' Affairs is
9 authorized to sell and convey all of the State's interest in 1.17± acres
10 of surplus real property located in the Borough of Red Bank,
11 Monmouth County. The property is designated as Block 62, Lot 17,
12 on the Borough of Red Bank tax map, and known as the Red Bank
13 Armory.

14 b. The sale shall be a direct sale to the municipality in which the
15 property is situated upon terms and conditions approved by the State
16 House Commission.¹

18 ¹[1.] 2.¹ P.L.1991, c.88 is repealed.

20 ¹[2.] 3.¹ This act shall take effect immediately.
