1 **AN ACT** concerning the Great Seal of the State of New Jersey and
2 amending P.L.1955, c.155.

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4 **BE IT ENACTED** *by the Senate and General Assembly of the State*
5 *of New Jersey:*

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7 1. Section 1 of P.L.1955, c.155 (C.52:2-3) is amended to read as
8 follows:

9 1. The Governor of the State, the head of any principal executive
10 department of the State, the members of the Legislature of the State,
11 the Justices of the Supreme Court, the judges of the Superior Court,
12 the county prosecutors, county clerks, surrogates and sheriffs, the
13 Secretary of the Senate, the Clerk of the General Assembly and
14 members of the Congress of the United States and each of them, are
15 authorized to use, exhibit and display the Great Seal of the State of
16 New Jersey, in whole or in part, including such use, exhibition and
17 display on their motor vehicle license plates.

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20 2. This act shall take effect immediately.

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STATEMENT

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25 This bill authorizes county clerks and surrogates to display the
26 Great Seal of the State of New Jersey, including its display on their
27 motor vehicle license plates. County prosecutors and sheriffs received
28 such statutory authority in 1991 (P.L.1991, c.191).

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33 Authorizes county clerks and surrogates to display Great Seal of New
34 Jersey, including its display on motor vehicle license plates.
