1 AN ACT establishing a Sexual Assault Nurse Examiner Program <sup>1</sup>[and]  
2 <sup>1</sup> supplementing Title 52 of the Revised Statutes <sup>1</sup>and  
3 making an appropriation<sup>1</sup>.

5 **BE IT ENACTED** by the Senate and General Assembly of the State  
6 of New Jersey:  
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8 1. The Legislature finds and declares that the Sexual Assault Nurse  
9 Examiner Model Project established pursuant to P.L.1995, c.187 and  
10 approved on July 27, 1995, will expire on July 27, 1997. The project  
11 has been successful in ensuring more timely and accurate collection of  
12 forensic evidence for use in prosecuting suspected rapists and in  
13 creating a compassionate way to treat sexual assault victims, and it is  
14 important to <sup>2</sup>[establish] continue<sup>2</sup> the program <sup>2</sup>[permanently]<sup>2</sup>.

16 2. a. <sup>1</sup>The Sexual Assault Nurse Examiner Model Project  
17 established pursuant to P.L.1995, c.187 is continued in accordance  
18 with the provisions of this act and shall be designated as the Sexual  
19 Assault Nurse Examiner Program in Monmouth county.<sup>1</sup> The Chief  
20 of the Office of Victim-Witness Advocacy in the Division of Criminal  
21 Justice in the Department of Law and Public Safety shall oversee the  
22 <sup>1</sup>[Sexual Assault Nurse Examiner Program in Monmouth county,  
23 established pursuant to P.L.1995, c.187] program in consultation with  
24 an advisory committee comprised of: the person designated by the  
25 advisory committee to serve as the program coordinator, and a  
26 representative from at least each of the following: the Attorney  
27 General, <sup>2</sup>the Division on Women in the Department of Community  
28 Affairs, <sup>2</sup>each hospital participating in the program, the Women's  
29 Center of Monmouth County, Inc., a law enforcement agency within  
30 the county, and the county prosecutor's office<sup>1</sup>. The chief may

1 contract with any agency, organization or other entity, as appropriate,  
2 to effectuate the purposes of this act, and that agency organization or  
3 other entity shall seek, to the maximum extent practicable, to obtain  
4 funds from nongovernmental sources as a supplement to State funds  
5 appropriated to operate the program.

6 b. The program shall be designed to use forensic nurse sexual  
7 assault examiners, who shall be registered professional nurses or nurse  
8 practitioners/clinical nurse specialists licensed in this State and trained  
9 in forensic science, in accordance with regulations adopted by the New  
10 Jersey Board of Nursing with the approval of the Attorney General, to  
11 perform sexual assault examinations in an area of the hospital  
12 designated solely for sexual assault examinations. The program shall  
13 work cooperatively with the rape crisis center operated by the  
14 Women's Center of Monmouth County, Inc., in providing assistance  
15 to each victim. A representative of the county prosecutor's office or  
16 the Office of Victim-Witness Advocacy shall meet with each victim,  
17 and counseling and other appropriate services pursuant to subsection  
18 c. of section 6 of P.L.1985, c.404 (C.52:4B-44c) shall be provided to  
19 each victim. The program shall provide the victim with the  
20 opportunity to tend to personal hygiene needs and to obtain fresh  
21 clothing, as appropriate.

22 c. The program staff shall offer assistance to other counties which  
23 may be interested in <sup>1</sup>[participating in the] establishing a similar<sup>1</sup>  
24 program.

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26 <sup>1</sup>3. There is appropriated \$90,000 from the General Fund to the  
27 Department of Law and Public Safety to carry out the provisions of  
28 this act.<sup>1</sup>

30 <sup>1</sup>[3.] 4.<sup>1</sup> The Attorney General, pursuant to the "Administrative  
31 Procedure Act," P.L.1968, c.410 (C.52:14B-1 et seq.), <sup>2</sup>[shall] may<sup>2</sup>  
32 adopt rules and regulations to effectuate the purposes of this act.
