1 AN ACT concerning payment of Victims of Crime Compensation
2 Board assessments and supplementing Title 30 of the Revised
3 Statutes.

5 **BE IT ENACTED** by the Senate and General Assembly of the State
6 of New Jersey:

8 1. ¹[a.]¹ Every commissary in a county or State correctional
9 facility operated for the sale of commodities shall collect a surcharge
10 of 10% of the sales price of every item sold. The surcharge shall be
11 known as the "VCCB Surcharge." All funds collected pursuant to this
12 section shall be forwarded to the State Treasurer for deposit in the
13 Victims of Crime Compensation Board Account, shall be subject to
14 reporting and accounting procedures pursuant to the provisions of
15 section 2 of P.L.1970, c.396 (C.2C:43-3.1) and shall be used in
16 satisfying claims pursuant to the provisions of the "Criminal Injuries
17 Compensation Act of 1971," P.L.1971, c.317 (C.52:4B-1 et seq.). A
18 sale subject to surcharge under this section shall not be subject to any
19 tax imposed under the "Sales and Use Tax Act," P.L.1966, c.30
20 (C.54:32B-1 et seq.).

21 ¹[b. Pursuant to the "Administrative Procedure Act," P.L.1968,
22 c.410 (C.52:14B-1 et seq.), the Commissioner of Corrections shall
23 adopt rules and regulations necessary to implement the provisions of
24 this act.]¹

26 2. This act shall take effect immediately ¹but section 1 shall remain
27 inoperative until the 180th day following enactment¹.
