1 AN ACT concerning boards of trustees and amending P.L.1970, c.102.

3 **BE IT ENACTED** by the Senate and General Assembly of the State
4 of New Jersey:

6 1. Section 4 of P.L.1970 c.102 (C.18A:64G-4) is amended to read
7 as follows:

8 4. a. The government, control, conduct, management and
9 administration of the university shall be vested in the board of trustees
10 of the university. The membership of the board of trustees shall consist
11 of the Commissioner of Health, who shall serve ex officio, without
12 vote, and **[11] 13** voting members, each of whom shall be appointed
13 by the Governor, with the advice and consent of the Senate, for a term
14 of five years and shall serve until his successor is appointed and has
15 qualified. Any vacancies in the voting membership of the board
16 occurring other than by expiration of term shall be filled in the same
17 manner as the original appointment but for the unexpired term only.
18 Each voting member of the board of trustees before entering upon his
19 duties shall take and subscribe an oath to perform the duties of his
20 office faithfully, impartially and justly to the best of his ability. A
21 record of such oath shall be filed in the office of the Secretary of State.
22 Each voting member of the board may be removed from office by the
23 Governor, for cause, after a public hearing.

24 b. The members of the board of trustees shall meet at the call of
25 the Governor for purposes of organizing. The board shall thereafter
26 meet at such times and places as it shall designate.

27 c. The Governor shall designate one of the voting members as
28 chairman of the board. The board shall select such other officers from
29 among its members as shall be deemed necessary.

30 d. The board shall have the power to appoint and regulate the
31 duties, functions, powers and procedures of committees, standing or
32 special, from its members and such advisory committees or bodies, as
33 it may deem necessary or conducive to the efficient management and
