1 AN ACT concerning motor vehicles and providing for the issuance of
2 special commemorative license plates.

3

4 **BE IT ENACTED** by the Senate and General Assembly of the State
5 of New Jersey:

6

7 1. a. Notwithstanding any provision of Title 39 of the Revised
8 Statutes to the contrary, the Director of the Division of Motor
9 Vehicles is authorized to issue a special license plate commemorating
10 the 75th Anniversary of the New Jersey State Police. The license plate
11 shall be of such design as shall be submitted to the director by the
12 State Police and as shall be approved by him, including such markings
13 or identification otherwise prescribed by law.

14 b. Except as provided in this act, the special commemorative
15 license plates shall not be sold or otherwise be made commercially
16 available and shall be issued to the State Police to be displayed on any
17 State Police motor vehicle to be marked as State property.

18 c. The special commemorative plates shall be displayed ¹[from the
19 date of their issuance to February 1, 1997] for one year from the
20 effective date of this legislation¹.

21 d. The Director of the Division of Motor Vehicles is authorized
22 to transmit such special commemorative plates, upon their surrender,
23 to the Former Troopers Association¹ [, donating the funding for such
24 special commemorative license plates]¹. The Association is authorized
25 to retain such plates for disposition to its members and members of the
26 State Police on active duty, in such manner and on such terms as ¹[it]¹
27 shall ¹[decide] be determined by the Superintendent of State Police in
28 consultation with the Director of the Division of Motor Vehicles¹.

29 e. Any monetary donation by the Former Troopers Association
30 made available to the State, which specifies the sponsorship of the

1 issuance of the special commemorative license plates, shall be
2 accepted by the director on behalf of the State ¹[and distributed for
3 motor vehicle purposes. Any such monetary donation shall be
4 included in the annual appropriations act and distributed in the same
5 manner as other appropriations] to defray the cost of administration,
6 design and production of the commemorative license plate¹.

8 2. This act shall take effect immediately and shall expire ¹[February
9 1, 1997] one year from the effective date¹.
