1 AN ACT concerning the office of sheriff and amending N.J.S.40A:9-
2 108.

4 **BE IT ENACTED** by the Senate and General Assembly of the State
5 of New Jersey:

7 1. N.J.S.40A:9-108 is amended to read as follows:

8 40A:9-108. No person shall hold any other civil office during the
9 time he holds and exercises the office of sheriff and by acceptance of
10 the latter office his former office shall be deemed vacated, provided,
11 however, that the governing body of any county may, by ordinance or
12 resolution, as appropriate, provide that any person holding and
13 exercising the office of sheriff may simultaneously hold and exercise
14 the office of county disaster control coordinator but shall not receive
15 any compensation or any other benefits otherwise attached to the
16 office of county disaster control coordinator during such time as such
17 person shall hold both such offices. As used in this section, the term
18 "civil office" does not mean an unpaid, part-time position on any
19 public board, commission, committee or similar body.

22 2. This act shall take effect immediately.

STATEMENT

27 Current law prohibits dual office holding by county sheriffs.
28 Although this law serves a useful purpose in preventing possible
29 conflicts of interest, it has been narrowly interpreted at times to
30 prevent a sheriff from serving part-time without compensation on a
31 board, commission or committee. Thus, sheriffs have been denied the
32 opportunity to share their knowledge and experience to the benefit of
33 the public by serving on bodies such as the Police Training
34 Commission. This bill would permit a sheriff to serve in an unpaid,
