1 AN ACT appropriating \$28,390,000 from the "Green Acres, Farmland
2 and Historic Preservation, and Blue Acres Bond Act of 1995,"
3 P.L.1995, c.204 for the development of lands by the State for
4 recreation and conservation purposes.

6 **BE IT ENACTED** by the Senate and General Assembly of the State
7 of New Jersey:

9 1. a. There is appropriated to the Department of Environmental
10 Protection from the "1995 New Jersey Green Acres Fund," established
11 pursuant to section 22 of the "Green Acres, Farmland and Historic
12 Preservation, and Blue Acres Bond Act of 1995," P.L.1995, c.204, the
13 sum of \$28,390,000 for the development of lands by the State for
14 recreation and conservation purposes. This sum shall include
15 administrative costs and shall be allocated for various State park and
16 forest renovation, rehabilitation and development projects as follows:

16 b. Any transfer of funds, change in project sponsor, or change in
 17 project site or type listed in subsection a. of this section shall require
 18 the approval of the Joint Budget Oversight Committee or its
 19 successor.

20 c. To the extent that moneys remain available after the projects
 21 listed in subsection a. of this section are offered funding pursuant
 22 thereto, the projects listed in P.L. , c. (C.) (now before the
 23 Legislature as Senate Bill No. of 1997 or Assembly Bill No. 2898 of
 24 1997) shall be eligible for additional funding, including administrative
 25 costs, utilizing those remaining moneys, in a sequence consistent with
 26 the priority system established by the Department of Environmental
 27 Protection, and with the approval of the Joint Budget Oversight
 28 Committee or its successor.

30 2. The expenditure of the sums appropriated by this act is subject
 31 to the provisions and conditions of P.L.1995, c.204.

33 3. This act shall take effect immediately.

38 This bill would appropriate \$28,390,000 from the "1995 New Jersey
 39 Green Acres Fund," established pursuant to section 22 of the "Green
 40 Acres, Farmland and Historic Preservation, and Blue Acres Bond Act
 41 of 1995," P.L.1995, c.204, for the development of lands in various
 42 state parks and forests by the State for recreation and conservation
 43 purposes. This sum would include administrative costs.
