1 A SUPPLEMENT to "An Act making appropriations for the support of
2 the State Government and the several public purposes for the fiscal
3 year ending June 30, 1997 and regulating the disbursement
4 thereof," approved June 28, 1996 (P.L.1996, c.42).

6 BE IT ENACTED by the Senate and General Assembly of the State
7 of New Jersey:

9 1. In addition to the amounts appropriated under P.L.1996, c.42,
10 there is appropriated out of the General Fund the following sum for
11 the purpose specified:

13 62 DEPARTMENT OF LABOR

14 50 Economic Planning, Development and Security

15 54 Manpower and Employment Services--Grants-In-Aid

23 2. This act shall take effect immediately.

26 STATEMENT

28 This bill appropriates \$60,000 to the Department of Labor for a
29 grant to the Institute for Arts and Humanities Education for the
30 establishment of an Arts Service Corps at the New Jersey Summer
31 Arts Institute. The Arts Service Corps will provide culturally diverse,
32 young artists, drawn from all of the State's counties, with an
33 opportunity to combine summer learning experiences with year-round
34 employment. By providing students with necessary skills and first
35 time work experience, the corps is intended to encourage students to
36 pursue additional education and training so that they may ultimately
37 qualify for more highly skilled jobs.
