1 AN ACT concerning summer sessions provided by boards of education  
2 and supplementing Title 18A of the New Jersey Statutes.

4 **BE IT ENACTED** *by the Senate and General Assembly of the State*  
5 *of New Jersey:*

7 1. Notwithstanding any law to the contrary, a board of education  
8 may charge tuition for any remedial course provided to a student who  
9 has been repeatedly suspended during the school year, as determined  
10 by the Commissioner of Education.

11 For the purposes of this section, remedial course means a course  
12 or subject which is a review of a course or subject previously taken,  
13 for which credits or placement may be awarded upon successful  
14 completion of the course.

16 2. This act shall take effect immediately.

STATEMENT

21 This bill would permit school districts to charge tuition for those  
22 students who attend a summer session operated by the board of  
23 education for a remedial course, if the attendance is due to repeated  
24 suspensions. The Commissioner of Education will determine how  
25 many suspensions will be required in order to permit a district to  
26 charge tuition for attendance at a summer session.

27 The bill defines "remedial course" as it is defined at N.J.A.C.6:8-  
28 8.1.
