INTRODUCED NOVEMBER 17, 1997

1 AN ACT concerning motor vehicle safety equipment and  
2 supplementing chapter 3 of Title 39 of the Revised Statutes.

4 **BE IT ENACTED** by the Senate and General Assembly of the State  
5 of New Jersey:

7 1. a. Every delivery van or truck registered in this State with a  
8 cube-style, walk-in cargo box up to 18-feet long that is used in the  
9 commercial delivery of goods and services shall be equipped with a  
10 rear crossview mirror located at the top left rear corner of the cargo  
11 box. The mirror shall be convex and located to reflect to the vehicle  
12 operator an unobstructed, overall view of the lower six feet of the  
13 entire rear width of the van or truck body.

14 b. The director may adopt regulations pursuant to the  
15 "Administrative Procedure Act," P.L.1968, c.410 (C.52:14B-1 et seq.)  
16 necessary to implement the provisions of this act.

18 2. This act shall take effect on the first day of the fourth month  
19 after enactment, but the director may take such anticipatory  
20 administrative action in advance as shall be necessary for the  
21 implementation of this act.

STATEMENT

25

26 To reduce the number of fatalities and injuries attributable to  
27 "backing accidents," this bill requires convex-shaped, rear crossview  
28 mirrors on every commercial delivery van or truck registered in this  
29 State if that vehicle is equipped with a cube-style, walk-in cargo box  
30 up to 18-feet long. The mirror is to be installed at the top left rear  
31 corner of the cargo box so that the operator of the van or truck has an  
32 unobstructed view of the lower six feet of the entire rear width of the  
33 van or truck body. The cost of a rear crossview mirror is  
34 approximately \$50.

35 According to the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration,  
36 168 persons were killed and 12,000 injured nationwide in backing  
37 accidents in 1994. The United States Department of Transportation

1 estimates that up to 130 of those killed each year in these accidents are  
2 children. Federal Express has reportedly experienced a 36 percent  
3 reduction in backing accidents since installing rear crossview mirrors  
4 on its delivery vans.
