1 AN ACT authorizing the payment of honoraria to public swimming
2 pool commission members and amending P.L.1957, c.166.

4 **BE IT ENACTED** by the Senate and General Assembly of the State
5 of New Jersey:

7 1. Section 4 of P.L.1957, c.166 (C.40:61-22.24) is amended to
8 read as follows:

9 4. The governing body of any municipality may assign the general
10 supervision and control over the maintenance, operation and
11 regulation of any such public swimming pool and all forms of
12 recreation, playground, and public entertainment activities carried on
13 in connection therewith, to the board or body, if any, in charge of
14 recreation in said municipality, or may provide, by ordinance, for the
15 appointment of a board of commissioners to consist of not more than
16 5 residents of the municipality who shall have such general
17 supervision and control. The members of such commission shall serve
18 without compensation, but their necessary expenses shall be allowed
19 and paid by the municipality: provided, however, that a municipality
20 may provide an annual honorarium of up to \$500 to each commission
21 member to reward the efforts of those persons on behalf of the
22 municipality.

30 This bill would authorize municipalities to provide an annual
