INTRODUCED NOVEMBER 17, 1997

1 AN ACT appropriating <sup>1</sup>[\$2.5]\$3.8<sup>1</sup> million from the "1996 Dredging  
2 and Containment Facility Fund," established pursuant to section 18  
3 of the "Port of New Jersey Revitalization, Dredging, Environmental  
4 Cleanup, Lake Restoration, and Delaware Bay Area Economic  
5 Development Bond Act of 1996," P.L.1996, c.70, for the dredging  
6 of various navigation channels not located in the port region.

7  
8 **BE IT ENACTED** *by the Senate and General Assembly of the State*  
9 *of New Jersey:*

11 1. There is appropriated to the Department of Environmental  
12 Protection from the "1996 Dredging and Containment Facility Fund,"  
13 established pursuant to section 18 of the "Port of New Jersey  
14 Revitalization, Dredging, Environmental Cleanup, Lake Restoration,  
15 and Delaware Bay Area Economic Development Bond Act of 1996,"  
16 P.L.1996, c.70, the sum of <sup>1</sup>[\$2.5] \$3.8<sup>1</sup> million for the cost of  
17 dredging the following navigation channels not located in the port  
18 region, in accordance with the provisions of section 7 of the "Port of  
19 New Jersey Revitalization, Dredging, Environmental Cleanup, Lake  
20 Restoration, and Delaware Bay Area Economic Development Bond  
21 Act of 1996," P.L.1996, c.70 <sup>1</sup>, and for the cost of any necessary  
22 chemical testing and boring in connection with the dredging<sup>1</sup>:
