1 AN ACT concerning superintendents of schools and amending
2 N.J.S.18A:17-18.

4 **BE IT ENACTED** *by the Senate and General Assembly of the State*
5 *of New Jersey:*

7 1. N.J.S.18A:17-18 is amended to read as follows:

8 18A:17-18. The superintendent of schools shall, when so required
9 by the board or boards of education of the district or districts
10 employing him, devote himself exclusively to the duties of his office.
11 The board or boards of education of the district or districts employing
12 the superintendent of schools shall not permit that person to also serve
13 as the school business administrator for the district or districts.

16 2. This act shall take effect immediately.

STATEMENT

21 This bill prohibits a superintendent of schools from also serving as
22 the school business administrator for the district which employs him.
23 It is the intent of this bill to ensure that school districts are operated
24 with an adequate system of checks and balances.

29 Prohibits superintendent of schools from also serving as the school
30 business administrator for a district.
