1	AN ACT to amend "An Act making appropriations for the support of
2	the State Government and the several public purposes for the fiscal
3	year ending June 30, 1998 and regulating the disbursement
4	thereof," approved June 27, 1997 (P.L.1997, c.131).

6	Be It Enacted by the Senate and General Assembly of the State
7	of New Jersey:

9	1. The following language provision is added to section 1 of
10	P.L.1997, c.131 (on page 64) as follows:

19	Receipts not to exceed \$400,000 from the Old Age, Survivors, and
20	Disability Insurance payments received by persons residing at any
21	of the developmental centers operated by the Department of
22	Human Services are appropriated to the Foster Grandparents
23	account to be used for the Foster Grandparents and Senior
24	Companion programs.

27	2. This act shall take effect immediately.

30	STATEMENT
31	
32	This bill appropriates up to \$400,000 in excess Old Age, Survivors,
33	and Disability Insurance payments received by persons residing at the
34	State developmental centers for use in the Foster Grandparents and

1	Senior Companion programs.
2	At present, over 500 persons residing at the State developmental
3	centers are in need of services provided by the Foster Grandparents and
4	Senior Companion programs. The \$400,000 would enable 180 persons
5	to receive services from these two programs.

10	Appropriates up to \$400,000 in revenues for the Foster Grandparents
11	and Senior Companionship programs.
