# **STATE OF NEW JERSEY**

#### INTRODUCED FEBRUARY 5, 1996

1	A SENATE RESOLUTION urging the President and Congress of the United
2	States to support the admission of the Republic of Poland to the North
3	Atlantic Treaty Organization.
4	
5	WHEREAS, The Republic of Poland is a free, democratic and independent
6	nation with a long and proud history; and
7	WHEREAS, The North Atlantic Treaty Organization is dedicated to the
8	preservation of the freedom and security of its member nations; and
9	WHEREAS, The Republic of Poland desires to share in both the benefits and
10	obligations of NATO in pursuing the development, growth and promotion
11	of democratic institutions and ensuring free market economic development;
12	and
13	WHEREAS, Poland recognizes its responsibilities as a democratic nation and
14	wishes to exercise such responsibilities in concert with members of NATO;
15	and
16	WHEREAS, The Republic of Poland desires to become part of NATO's efforts
17	to prevent the extremes of nationalism; and
18	WHEREAS, The security of the United States is dependent upon the stability
19	of Central Europe; now, therefore,
20	
21	BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the State of New Jersey:
22	
23	1. This House respectfully urges the President of the United States and the
24	Congress of the United States to support the Republic of Poland's petition for
25	admission to the North Atlantic Treaty Organization and to support the
26	establishment during 1996 of a timetable for such admission.
27	
28	2. Duly authenticated copies of this resolution, signed by the President of
29	the Senate shall be transmitted to the President of the United States, the
30	Presiding Officer of both branches of the United States Congress, the
31	Members thereof from the State of New Jersey and Marek Lesniewski-Laas,
32	the Honorary Consul of the Republic of Poland.
