1 A SENATE RESOLUTION memorializing the Congress of the United States to

2	preserve deductions for home mortgage interest, property taxes and
3	charitable contributions by rejecting any tax proposal that would eliminate
4	these deductions.
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6	WHEREAS, Recent highly publicized proposals for a so-called "flat" income
7	tax call for the elimination of deductions this country's taxpayers have long
8	enjoyed for home mortgage interest, property taxes and charitable
9	contributions; and
10	WHEREAS, Home ownership and charitable giving represent fundamental
11	American ideals which promote social and economic benefits beyond the
12	benefits that accrue to the occupant of the home or to the contributor; and
13	WHEREAS, Home ownership is an important factor in promoting economic
14	security and stability for American families and elimination of the home
15	mortgage interest or property tax deductions will reduce existing property
16	values by 15 percent or more; and
17	WHEREAS, The current federal income tax deductions for home mortgage
18	interest and property taxes have been valuable cornerstones of this nation's
19	housing policy for most of this century and comprise the most important
20	component of housing-related tax policy in America today; and
21	WHEREAS, The continued deductibility of home mortgage interest and
22	property taxes is of crucial importance to the economies of many
23	communities; and
24	WHEREAS, Eliminating deductions for home mortgage interest and property
25	taxes will make the cost of participating in the American dream of owning
26	a home beyond the reach of many American families; and
27	WHEREAS, Eliminating the charitable contributions deduction will result in a
28	decrease in contributions and financial instability among charitable
29	organizations; and
30	WHEREAS, It is altogether fitting and proper that the policy of the federal
31	government is, and should continue to be, to encourage home ownership
32	and charitable contributions; now, therefore,
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1	Be it resolved by the Senate of the State of New Jersey:
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3	1. This House respectfully memorializes the Congress of the United States
4	to reject any tax proposal that eliminates deductions for home mortgage
5	interest, property taxes and charitable contributions.
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7	2. Duly authenticated copies of this resolution, signed by the Senate
8	President and attested to by the Senate Secretary, shall be
9	transmitted to the Vice President of the United States, the Speaker of the
10	House of Representatives, and each member of the Congress elected from this
11	State.
