1	A SENATE RESOLUTION memorializing the federal Food and Drug
2	Administration to lift its ban on RU486 and approve its use in this country.
3	
4	WHEREAS, Mifepristone, known as RU486, a pill which, among other uses,
5	induces abortion in the very early stages of pregnancy, has been in use in
6	France since its approval there in 1988; and
7	WHEREAS, RU486 has proven to be a safe and effective method of
8	termination of pregnancy, marking a great advancement over other
9	pregnancy-ending techniques and offering women a non-surgical choice
10	preferable to an invasive surgical procedure; and over 60,000 French
11	women have used RU486 successfully; and
12	WHEREAS, RU486 has also been used effectively in cases of prolonged and
13	difficult labor, often reducing the need for a Caesarean section; has been
14	valuable in treating Cushing's disease; and appears to be a promising
15	treatment for brain tumors and ovarian and breast cancers; and
16	WHEREAS, The American Medical Association passed a resolution in 1990
17	supporting the legal availability of RU486 for appropriate research and, if
18	indicated, clinical practice; and
19	WHEREAS, The federal Food and Drug Administration has imposed an import
20	ban on RU486, effectively halting any research involving the drug in this
21	country; now, therefore,

23 24	BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the State of New Jersey:
25	1. The federal Food and Drug Administration is urged to lift its ban on the
26	importation of RU486 due to its significant medical value and to approve the
27	use of RU486 for research and clinical practice in the United States.

29	2. Duly authenticated copies of this resolution, signed by the President and
30	attested by the Secretary, shall be transmitted to the Commissioner of the
31	United States Food and Drug Administration, the United States Secretary of
32	Health and Human Services and every member of the Congress of the United
33	States elected from the State of New Jersey.

1 This resolution urges the federal Food and Drug Administration to lift its 2 ban on importation of the pill known as RU486 due to its significant medical 3 value and to approve its use for research and clinical practice in the United 4 States. RU486, which, among other uses, induces abortion when 5 administered in the very early stages of pregnancy, has been used successfully 6 by over 60,000 French women since its approval in that country in 1988. The 7 pill has also been used effectively in cases of prolonged and difficult labor, 8 often reducing the need for a Caesarean section; has been valuable in treating 9 Cushing's disease; and appears to be a promising treatment for brain tumors 10 and ovarian and breast cancers. 11 12 13 14
