

SENATE RESOLUTION No. 65

1 A SENATE RESOLUTION commemorating 25 years of service by Ramapo  
2 College of New Jersey as a leading public liberal arts college.  
3  
4 WHEREAS, Ramapo College of New Jersey was created in 1969 to be a  
5 new kind of institution, a public liberal arts college; and  
6 WHEREAS, The college welcomed its first students in September of 1971; and  
7 WHEREAS, Twenty-five years later, Ramapo College has achieved  
8 international recognition as a college of liberal arts education, with  
9 outstanding faculty and programs and an increasingly selective student  
10 body; and  
11 WHEREAS, Ramapo College has received recognition from the Middle States  
12 Association of Colleges and Schools and from New Jersey officials, and  
13 offers an education equivalent to that provided at such fine public liberal  
14 arts colleges as Mary Washington College in Virginia, St. Mary's College  
15 of Maryland, and The Evergreen State College in Washington State; and  
16 WHEREAS, Ramapo College has, during its illustrious twenty-five year history,  
17 grown steadily in size and reputation while adhering to its original mission  
18 of providing quality, affordable liberal arts education; and  
19 WHEREAS, A quarter century of service is an opportune time to congratulate  
20 the college as a leading public liberal arts education institution and renew  
21 the State's commitment to the college's founding mission; now, therefore,

23 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the State of New Jersey:

25 1. This House commemorates 25 years of service by Ramapo College of  
26 New Jersey as a leading public liberal arts college.

28 2. A duly authenticated copy of this resolution, signed by the President of  
29 the Senate and attested by the Secretary of the Senate, shall be transmitted to  
30 the President of Ramapo College of New Jersey.
