SENATE RESOLUTION No. 88

INTRODUCED APRIL 17, 1997

1	A SENATE RESOLUTION calling upon all New Jerseyans to make themselves
2	aware of religious persecution throughout the world and to urge their
3	representatives in the Congress of the United States and the President of
4	the United States to take certain actions.
5	
6	WHEREAS, The columnist A. M. Rosenthal of The New York Times has
7	provided a valuable service to its readers with his column of February 11,
8	1997 in which he called attention to the persecution of Christians
9	throughout the world, especially as highlighted by Nina Shea, director of
10	the Puebla Program of Freedom House, in her book In the Lion's Den;
11	and
12	WHEREAS, Ms. Shea notes that "Millions of American Christians pray in their
13	churches each week, oblivious to the fact that Christians in many parts of
14	the world suffer brutal torture, arrest, imprisonment and even deaththeir
15	homes and communities laid wastefor no other reason than that they are
16	Christians"; and
17	WHEREAS, Ms. Shea also notes that "The shocking untold story of our time is
18	that more Christians have died this century simply for being Christians than
19	in the first nineteen centuries after the birth of Christ" and that "They have
20	been persecuted and martyred before an unknowing, indifferent world and
21	a largely silent Christian community"; and
22	WHEREAS, According to Ms. Shea, "Eleven countries where Christians are
23	currently enduring great religious persecution are China, Sudan, Pakistan,
24	North Korea, Saudi Arabia, Vietnam, Egypt, Nigerian, Cuba, Laos and
25	Uzbekistan"; and
26	WHEREAS, The persecutions include: a pogrom in the Sudan, where the
27	Islamic militant government has bombed and burned Christian villages,
28	taken Christian children as slaves, and tortured Christian worshipers and
29	their priests; the prohibition in Saudi Arabia of any public expression of
30	Christianity or any religion but Islam; the imprisonment in China of
31	thousands of Roman Catholic and Protestant Chinese for holding worship,
32	preaching, or distributing Bibles without permission; and
33	WHEREAS, There is the need for greater consciousness of these persecutions
34	and greater efforts to fight not only this oppression of Christians but
35	oppression of any religious group; now, therefore,

1	BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the State of New Jersey:

3	This House calls upon all New Jerseyans to make themselves aware of
4	religious persecution throughout the world and to urge their representatives in
5	the Congress of the United States and the President of the United States to
6	adopt any legislation which strengthens the rights of religious refugees and
7	applies economic pressures against the regimes responsible for such
8	persecution.

11	STATEMENT

13	This resolution notes the persecution of Christians occurring throughout the
14	world and calls upon all New Jerseyans to make themselves aware of religious
15	persecution throughout the world and to urge their representatives in the
16	Congress of the United States and the President of the United States to adopt
17	any legislation which strengthens the rights of religious refugees and applies
18	economic pressures against the regimes responsible for such persecution.

23	Calls upon all New Jerseyans to make themselves aware of religious
24	persecution throughout the world and to urge their representatives in the
25	Congress and the President to take certain actions.
