| 10 | in teach-ins, neighborhood cleanups, bill signings, and other activities to |
| 11 | demonstrate their concern for the environment and their desire to learn |
| 12 | more about nature, ecology, and other environmental concerns; and |
| 13 | WHEREAS, Earth Day 1970 was also the birth date of the New Jersey |
| 14 | Department of Environmental Protection as it is presently constituted, a |
| 15 | department which has, together with the Legislature, county and local |
| 16 | governments, the regulated community, and countless public interest and |
| 17 | local groups, developed and implemented numerous environmental |
| 18 | programs designed to preserve, protect and enhance the environment and |
| 19 | natural resources of this State; and |
| 20 | WHEREAS, April 22, 1997, the 27th anniversary of Earth Day, offers New |
| 21 | Jersey citizens an opportunity to reflect on the past years of progress in |
| 22 | environmental protection; and |

| 24 | to look forward to the work yet to be done, and to rededicate themselves, |
| 25 | with the level of commitment and concern demonstrated over the past |
