1 AN ACT concerning registration of historic cars and amending
2 P.L.1964, c.195.

4 **BE IT ENACTED** by the Senate and General Assembly of the State
5 of New Jersey:

7 1. Section 2 of P.L.1964, c.195 (C.39:3-27.4) is amended to read
8 as follows:

9 2. Any owner of an historic motor vehicle who is a resident of this
10 State may register such motor vehicle under the provisions of this act.
11 Application for registering an historic vehicle shall be on forms
12 prescribed by the director. Upon proper application and payment of
13 the prescribed fee, the director shall issue a special nonconventional
14 registration and special license plate for each historic motor vehicle
15 registered in this State. Such registration and license plate shall be
16 valid during the period of time that the vehicle is owned by the
17 registrant. The fee for such registration and license plate shall be
18 \$25.00. The license plate shall bear the word "historic" and shall be
19 of such design and colors as the director may determine.
20 Notwithstanding the provisions of R.S.39:3-33 or any other law to
21 the contrary, an owner of a vehicle registered as an historic vehicle
22 shall not be required to display more than one special license plate
23 issued for that vehicle, which plate shall be displayed on the rear of the
24 vehicle.

STATEMENT

32 This bill would provide that the owner of a vehicle registered as
33 historic, which is defined under statute as a car at least 25 years old,
34 which is owned as a collector's item and used solely for exhibition and
35 educational purposes, shall not be required to display two historic
36 license plates on such a vehicle. An historic license plate may be
37 displayed solely on the rear of such a vehicle.
