

SYNOPSIS

Permits DMVA to receive voluntary contributions for veteran suicide prevention public service announcements.

CURRENT VERSION OF TEXT

Introduced Pending Technical Review by Legislative Counsel.



1 AN ACT permitting the Department of Military and Veterans Affairs
2 to accept moneys for veteran suicide prevention public service
3 announcements and supplementing chapter 13 of Title 38A of the
4 New Jersey Statutes.

6 BE IT ENACTED *by the Senate and General Assembly of the State*
7 *of New Jersey:*

9 1. The Department of Military and Veterans Affairs shall be
10 permitted to accept moneys received by the department as gifts,
11 grants, or donations from the public and private sectors for the
12 purpose of public service announcements for the prevention of
13 veteran suicide.

14 Moneys received by the department pursuant to this section shall
15 be deposited into a special nonlapsing fund maintained by the State
16 Treasurer. Moneys credited to such account shall be appropriated
17 solely to fund public service announcements for the prevention of
18 veteran suicide.

20 2. This act shall take effect immediately.

23 STATEMENT

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25 This bill permits the Department of Military and Veterans
26 Affairs (DMAVA) to accept gifts, grants, donations from the public
27 and private sectors for the purpose of public service announcements
28 for the prevention of veteran suicide. Revenues received by the
29 department will be deposited into a special nonlapsing fund
30 maintained by the State Treasurer.
