1. a. The Department of Health shall develop and implement a plan to improve access to <sup>1</sup>[postpartum depression] perinatal mood and anxiety disorder <sup>1</sup> screening, referral, treatment, and support

b. The plan shall provide strategies to:

(1) increase awareness among mental health care service providers who treat women experiencing <sup>1</sup>[postpartum depression] perinatal mood and anxiety disorders <sup>1</sup> with regard to the prevalence and effects of <sup>1</sup>[postpartum depression] perinatal mood and anxiety disorders <sup>1</sup> on women and children;

- (2) establish a referral network of mental health care providers and support services for women who are in need of <sup>1</sup>[postpartum depression] perinatal mood and anxiety disorder <sup>1</sup> treatment;
- (3) increase women's access to formal and informal peer support services, including access to certified peer specialists who have received training related to <sup>1</sup>[postpartum depression] perinatal mood and anxiety disorders<sup>1</sup>;
- (4) raise public awareness for, and reduce the stigma related to, 

  1 [postpartum depression] perinatal mood and anxiety disorders 1; and
- (5) provide available funds to <sup>1</sup> [postpartum depression] <u>perinatal</u> mood and anxiety disorder <sup>1</sup> screening, referral, treatment, and support.
