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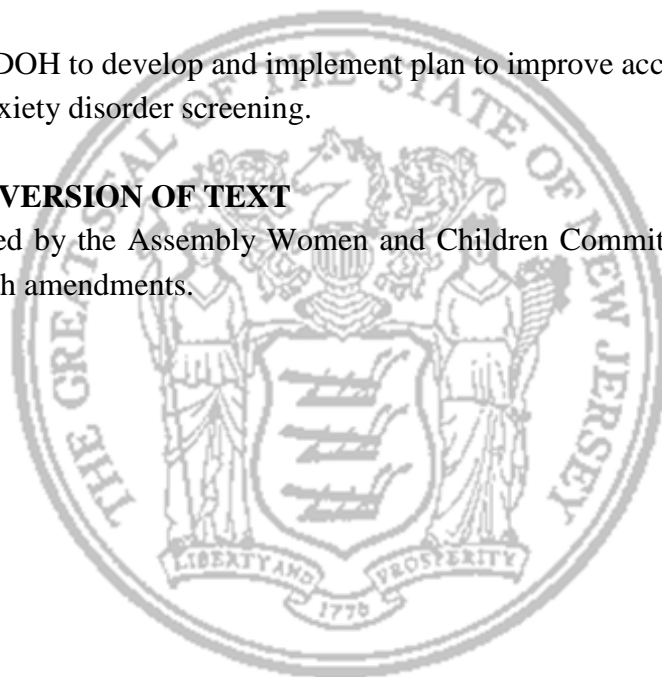

SYNOPSIS

Requires DOH to develop and implement plan to improve access to perinatal mood and anxiety disorder screening.

1 AN ACT concerning mental health and supplementing Title 26 of
2 the Revised Statutes.

4 **BE IT ENACTED** by the Senate and General Assembly of the State
5 of New Jersey:

7 1. a. The Department of Health shall develop and implement a
8 plan to improve access to ¹**postpartum depression** perinatal mood
9 and anxiety disorder¹ screening, referral, treatment, and support
10 services.

11 b. The plan shall provide strategies to:

12 (1) increase awareness among mental health care service providers
13 who treat women experiencing ¹**postpartum depression** perinatal
14 mood and anxiety disorders¹ with regard to the prevalence and effects
15 of ¹**postpartum depression** perinatal mood and anxiety disorders¹ on
16 women and children;

17 (2) establish a referral network of mental health care providers and
18 support services for women who are in need of ¹**postpartum**
19 **depression** perinatal mood and anxiety disorder¹ treatment;

20 (3) increase women's access to formal and informal peer support
21 services, including access to certified peer specialists who have
22 received training related to ¹**postpartum depression** perinatal mood
23 and anxiety disorders¹;

24 (4) raise public awareness for, and reduce the stigma related to,
25 ¹**postpartum depression** perinatal mood and anxiety disorders¹; and

26 (5) provide available funds to ¹**postpartum depression** perinatal
27 mood and anxiety disorder¹ screening, referral, treatment, and support.

29 2. The Commissioner of Health shall adopt rules and
30 regulations, in accordance with the "Administrative Procedure Act,"
31 P.L.1968, c.410 (C.52:14B-1 et seq.), as are necessary to effectuate
32 the provisions of this act.

33

34 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
