SYNOPSIS

Permits pet dogs in farmers markets under certain circumstances.

48 (2) pet dogs are not allowed in areas in which food is prepared;

1 (3) pet dogs are not allowed on seats or tables in dining areas
2 within the farmers market;

3 (4) employees who handle food are not permitted to touch pet
4 dogs, and if they do so, they must wash their hands afterward;

5 (5) dining areas at the market are kept clean and are sanitized if
6 they come into contact with dog excrement or other bodily fluids;
7 and

8 (6) the owner or operator of the market complies with local
9 ordinances related to public nuisance and sanitation.

10 This bill also requires each owner or operator of an indoor or
11 outdoor farmers market to post signage on the premises of the
12 farmers market notifying the public if pet dogs are permitted in the
13 farmers market and the guidelines to be followed for the pet dog to
14 be allowed in the farmers market.

15 The provisions of the bill would be enforced in the same manner
16 as the State Sanitary Code.
