AN ACT concerning the placement of international students in 1 public schools and supplementing Title ¹[52] 18A¹ of the 2 **Revised Statutes.** 3 4 5 **BE IT ENACTED** by the Senate and General Assembly of the State 6 of New Jersey: 7 8 1. As used in P.L. (C.) (pending before the , c. 9 Legislature as this bill): ¹"Commissioner" means the Commissioner of the New Jersey 10 Department of Education.¹ 11 "International student exchange visitor" or "student" means a 12 person 18 years of age or under, or up to age 21 if enrolled or to be 13 14 enrolled in high school in this State, placed by an international 15 student exchange visitor placement organization, who enters the United States with a nonimmigrant visa. 16 17 "International student exchange visitor placement organization" or "organization" means a person, partnership, corporation, school, 18 19 or other entity that regularly arranges the placement of international 20 student exchange visitors for the purpose, in whole or in part, of 21 allowing the student an opportunity to attend school in the United 22 States. 23 ¹["Secretary" means the Secretary of State of New Jersey.]¹ 24 An international student exchange visitor placement 25 2. a. organization that places students in public schools in the State shall 26 27 register with the ¹[Secretary of State] Commissioner of Education¹. To be eligible for registration, an international student exchange 28 29 visitor placement organization shall: 30 (1) be in compliance with United States Department of State 31 regulations on exchange visitor programs at 22 C.F.R. s.62.1 32 through 62.17, and at 22 C.F.R. 62.25, or be certified by the 33 Council of Standards for International Educational Travel and be 34 listed on the council's Advisory List of International Educational 35 Travel and Exchange Programs; and (2) present to the ¹[secretary] <u>commissioner</u>¹ current credentials 36 37 from the United States Department of State or the Council of 38 Standards for International Educational Travel that attest to such 39 compliance. b. Registration with the ¹[secretary] <u>commissioner</u>¹ shall not be 40 considered or represented as an endorsement of the organization by 41 the ¹[secretary] <u>commissioner</u>¹ or by the State. 42 Information provided to the '[secretary] commissioner¹ pursuant to P.L. 43) (pending before the Legislature as this bill) is a public 44 (C. C. 45 record.
