Requires DHS to contract with third party entity to apply risk reduction model to Medicaid prescription drug services.

1 **AN ACT** concerning prescription drug services provided under the
2 Medicaid program and supplementing Title 30 of the Revised
3 Statutes.

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5 **BE IT ENACTED** *by the Senate and General Assembly of the State*
6 *of New Jersey:*

8 1. The Division of Medical Assistance and Health Services in
9 the Department of Human Services shall contract with a third party
10 entity to apply a risk reduction model to prescription drug services
11 provided under the Medicaid program established pursuant to
12 P.L.1968, c.413 (C.30:4D-1 et seq.), for the purpose of identifying
13 and reducing simultaneous, multi-drug medication-related risk and
14 adverse drug events, enhancing compliance and quality of care, and
15 improving health-related outcomes while reducing total cost of care
16 in a measurable and reportable manner. In carrying out this
17 purpose, the model, at a minimum, shall leverage Medicaid
18 prescription drug claims data, pharmacokinetic and
19 pharmacodynamic sciences, appropriate technologies, clinical call
20 centers located in New Jersey and staffed by board-certified
21 pharmacists licensed pursuant to P.L.2003, c.280 (C.45:14-40 et
22 seq.), and include coordination of services with a network of local
23 community pharmacies located throughout the State. For the
24 duration of the contract, the division shall share the medical and
25 pharmacy claims data for all Medicaid beneficiaries with the third
26 party administering the model for the purposes of effectuating the
27 model, which claims data shall include historical data.

29 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
