BE IT ENACTED by the Senate and General Assembly of the State of New Jersey:

1. R.S.32:14-4 is amended to read as follows:

9 Palisades Interstate Park Commission shall have 32:14-4. 10 power to appoint such employees as it may deem necessary to carry 11 out the provisions of the Palisades Interstate Park compact and the 12 purposes of this subtitle, subject to the provisions of the applicable 13 Civil Service Statute of the party states, and may employ counsel. 14 It may also determine the duties of its appointees, and make all 15 reasonable rules and regulations respecting them. The commission 16 shall have power to take any action necessary for securing and 17 maintaining the benefits of the State employee retirement system of 18 this State for its employees in this State and for such purpose 19 employees of the commission to the extent to which the 20 compensation paid for their services is derived from funds 21 appropriated by this State or received from other sources in this 22 State shall be deemed to be employees of this State and qualified 23 for membership in said retirement system whether residents of this 24 State or of the State of New York. For the purpose of determining 25 their rights under the workers' compensation act of this State, 26 employees of the commission employed wholly or partly in this 27 State, and persons participating, under the supervision of the 28 commission, in volunteer programs in that part of the Palisades 29 Interstate Park located in New Jersey, shall be deemed to be 30 employees of this State.

Employees of the commission whose salary is paid in full from funds appropriated by this State shall be deemed to be employees of this State for the purpose of covering such employees under the provisions of Title 11 (Civil Service) of the Revised Statutes as herein provided.

36 All offices, positions or employments held by such employees on 37 the effective date of this amendatory act and so held continuously 38 for a period of not less than six months prior thereto, which can be 39 allocated to the classified service in accordance with the provisions 40 of Title 11 of the Revised Statutes, shall be so allocated under 41 appropriate titles by the Civil Service Commission and such persons 42 shall be recorded, without examination, as having been permanently 43 appointed thereto as of the dates of their respective original 44 appointments by the commission under said titles and shall 45 thereafter be under and subject to all provisions of Title 11 relating

the Civil Service Commission shall determine should be allocated
to the unclassified service, shall be allocated to the unclassified
service.

5 In the case of any such employees whose positions have been 6 classified and allocated by the Civil Service Commission to a salary 7 range corresponding to a range in the State compensation plan to 8 which range positions having the same title in the service of the 9 State, if any, are allocated and whose salaries in such range have 10 been determined in accordance with the provisions of Title 11, the 11 salaries of such employees upon being placed in allocated positions 12 in the service of the State shall, with the approval of the budget 13 director, be determined in the same manner as though they had been holding allocated positions in the service of the State. 14 Other 15 employees deemed to be employees of the State shall continue to be 16 paid the salaries received by them immediately prior to the effective 17 date of this act, but the salary of any such employee shall not be 18 less than the minimum salary of the State salary range in which his 19 position is allocated nor in excess of the maximum salary of such 20 range.

The Civil Service Commission shall make provisions for transfer of all employees' sick and vacation leave as well as seniority credits accrued prior to allocation of their positions to the classified service.

25 Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary, the 26 salary paid to a Palisades Interstate Park officer appointed pursuant 27 to R.S.32:14-21 shall be equivalent to the average base salary paid to a law enforcement officer employed by a contiguous 28 29 municipality with the equivalent training, experience, and years of 30 service. Any difference between base salaries paid to the Palisades 31 Interstate Park officers prior to the effective date of P.L. c, (C.) (pending before the Legislature as this bill) and 32 33 base salaries paid following the effective date of P.L. c, (C.) (pending before the Legislature as this bill) shall be allocated from 34 35 the General Fund. 36 As used in this section, "base salary" means the salary provided

37 pursuant to a salary guide or table and any amount provided
38 pursuant to a salary increment, including any amount provided for
39 longevity or length of service.

42 2. This act shall take effect on the first day of the third month
43 next following the date of enactment, but the Palisades Interstate
44 Park Commission may take any anticipatory action necessary to
45 effectuate the purposes of this act.

STATEMENT

2 3 This bill requires the base salary paid to Palisades Interstate Park officers to be equivalent to the average base salary paid to law 4 5 enforcement officers employed by a contiguous municipality with the equivalent training, experience, and years of service. Under the 6 7 bill, any salary increases paid to Palisades Interstate Park officers 8 following the bill's enactment are to be allocated from the General 9 Fund. 10

The bill defines "base salary" as the salary provided pursuant to
a salary guide or table and any amount provided pursuant to a salary
increment, including any amount provided for longevity or length of

13 service.
