### A5694 [1R] HOUGHTALING, DOWNEY

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AN ACT concerning eligibility for enrollment in a school district
and supplementing chapter 38 of Title 18A of the New Jersey
Statutes.

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**BE IT ENACTED** by the Senate and General Assembly of the State of New Jersey:

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1. Notwithstanding the provisions of N.J.S.18A:38-1 or any 8 9 other section of law to the contrary, a member of the armed forces 10 of the United States, the National Guard, or any other reserve 11 component of the armed forces who has received relocation orders 12 and whose anticipated residence will be within the State shall be 13 permitted to enroll a dependent child in a school district and register 14 for courses in advance of the member's relocation<sup>1</sup>, upon 15 presentation of a copy of the relocation orders to the school district. Once enrolled, the child shall be permitted to attend classes and 16 17 receive services free of charge in the same manner as if they were already a resident of the school district<sup>1</sup>. The school district shall 18 waive any proof of residency requirements until such time that the 19 20 member's family has been relocated within the school district. 21 22 <sup>1</sup>2.
