BE IT ENACTED by the Senate and General Assembly of the State

The Division of Veterans' ¹[Administrative] <u>Healthcare</u>¹ 10 Services in the Department of Military and Veterans' Affairs shall 11 ensure that each veterans' memorial home shall hold quarterly town 12 hall meetings with all veterans' guardians appointed pursuant to 13 section 1 of P.L.1993, c.281 (C.38A:3-2b2 et seq.), and persons 14 otherwise having the veteran's power of attorney.

16 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
