

6 **BE IT ENACTED** by the Senate and General Assembly of the State
7 of New Jersey:

9 1. The Division of Veterans' ¹**[Administrative]** Healthcare¹
10 Services in the Department of Military and Veterans' Affairs shall
11 ensure that each veterans' memorial home shall hold quarterly town
12 hall meetings with all veterans' guardians appointed pursuant to
13 section 1 of P.L.1993, c.281 (C.38A:3-2b2 et seq.), and persons
14 otherwise having the veteran's power of attorney. ²The meetings may
15 take place in-person or remotely using the Internet or other electronic
16 means.²

18 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
