AN ACT concerning certain lights used on motor vehicles and supplementing Title 39 of the Revised Statutes. **BE IT ENACTED** by the Senate and General Assembly of the State of New Jersey:

7 1. The Chief Administrator of the New Jersey Motor Vehicle 8 Commission shall promulgate rules and regulations governing the 9 use of light-emitting diode (LED) lighting bars on motor vehicles 10 that are not used for public safety, law enforcement, construction, 11 or other similar purposes. The rules and regulations shall specify 12 the appropriate use of an LED lighting bar on motor vehicles, 13 specifications for the location, luminosity, and size of an LED 14 lighting bar, and any other requirements that the chief administrator 15 deems appropriate, including the establishment of a permit process 16 if the chief administrator so determines.

STATEMENT

23 This bill requires the Chief Administrator of the New Jersey 24 Motor Vehicle Commission to promulgate rules and regulations 25 governing the use of LED lighting bars on motor vehicles that are 26 not used for public safety, law enforcement, construction, or other 27 similar purposes.
