#### **SYNOPSIS**

Permits exemption from civil service examination requirement for entry-level law enforcement officers, sheriff's officers, and county correctional police officers; permits hiring of such officers under certain conditions.

### CURRENT VERSION OF TEXT

As reported by the Assembly Appropriations Committee on December 13, 2021, with amendments.

AN ACT concerning civil service <sup>1</sup> [law enforcement] <sup>1</sup> examination 1 requirement for <sup>1</sup>entry-level law enforcement officers, sheriff's 2 officers, and county correctional police officers, and amending 3 4 P.L.2021, c.7.

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BE IT ENACTED by the Senate and General Assembly of the State of New Jersey:

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- 1. Section 1 of P.L.2021, c.7 (C.11A:4-1.3) is amended to read as follows:
- 1. a. The Civil Service Commission shall exempt from the requirement to take an examination for an entry-level law enforcement <sup>1</sup>officer <sup>1</sup> position <sup>1</sup>, entry-level <sup>2</sup>[sherrif's] sheriff's <sup>2</sup> officer position, or entry-level county correctional police officer position a person who <sup>1</sup>[has]<sup>1</sup> successfully <sup>1</sup>[completed] completes<sup>1</sup> a full Basic Course for Police Officers training course <sup>1</sup>or a full Basic Course for Correction Officers training course <sup>1</sup> at a school approved and authorized by the New Jersey Police Training commission <sup>1</sup>within nine months from the date of hire as a provisional entry-level officer under the provisions of this section.
  - (1) Any person employed under the provisions of this section shall enroll in a training course approved by the New Jersey Police Training Commission, and such person shall be entitled to a leave of absence with pay during the period of the training course.
  - (2) Upon successful completion of the training course, any person employed under the provisions of this section shall be promoted from a provisional entry-level law enforcement police officer, provisional entry-level <sup>2</sup>[sherrif's] sheriff's officer, or provisional entry-level county correctional police officer to an entry-level law enforcement officer, entry-level sheriff's officer, or entry-level county correctional police officer, as appropriate<sup>1</sup>.

- <sup>1</sup>(1)<sup>1</sup> A municipal or county police department may hire a 38 39 person, exempt from the requirement to take an examination for an 40 entry-level law enforcement <sup>1</sup>officer<sup>1</sup> position pursuant to 41 subsection a. of this section, upon adoption of an ordinance or 42 resolution by the governing body authorizing such hiring by the police department and the adoption of a conflict of interest and 43 44 nepotism policy.

<sup>1</sup>(2) A county <sup>2</sup>[sherrif's] sheriff's<sup>2</sup> department may hire a person, exempt from the requirement to take an examination for an entry-level sheriff's officer position pursuant to subsection a. of this section, upon <sup>2</sup>[adoption of an ordinance or resolution by the governing body authorizing such hiring by the sheriff's department and]<sup>2</sup> the adoption <sup>2</sup>by the county sheriff<sup>2</sup> of a conflict of interest and nepotism policy.

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- (3) A county correctional facility <sup>2</sup>, except one under the control 8 or supervision of a county sheriff,<sup>2</sup> may hire a person, exempt from 9 the requirement to take an examination for an entry-level county 10 correctional police officer position pursuant to subsection a. of this 11 12 section, upon adoption of an ordinance or a resolution by the governing body authorizing such hiring by the county correctional 13 facility and the adoption of a conflict of interest and nepotism 14 policy. <sup>1</sup> <sup>2</sup>A county correctional facility that is under the control or 15 16 supervision of a county sheriff may hire a person, exempt from the requirement to take an examination for an entry-level county 17 18 correctional police officer position pursuant to subsection a. of this 19 section, upon the adoption by the county sheriff of a conflict of interest and nepotism policy, without the need for an ordinance or a 20 resolution by the governing body<sup>2</sup> 21
  - <sup>1</sup>[A county correctional facility may hire a person, exempt from the requirement to take an examination for an entry-level county correctional police officer position pursuant to subsection a. of this section, upon adoption of a resolution by the governing body authorizing such hiring by the correctional facility and the adoption of a conflict of interest and nepotism policy.] <sup>2</sup>[A municipal or county police department, county sheriff's department, or county correctional facility shall not utilize the provisions of this section to circumvent the intergovernmental transfer process regulations established by the Civil Service Commission requiring written authorization from the departing authority Permanent entry-level officers and entry-level officers serving in a working test period who are employed by a municipal or county police department, county sheriff's department, or county correctional facility shall not be appointed by a different municipal or county police department, county sheriff's department, or county correctional facility utilizing the provisions of this section and municipal or county police departments, county sheriff's departments, or county correctional facilities may not utilize the provisions of this section to circumvent the intergovernmental transfer process regulations established by the Civil Service Commission for officers which requires written authorization from the departing authority<sup>2</sup>.
  - e. The Civil Service Commission shall promulgate, pursuant to the "Administrative Procedure Act," P.L.1968, c.410 (C.52:14B-1 et seq.), rules and regulations and establish administrative processes
