AN ACT establishing the "²[Community]² Broadband ²<u>Access</u>² 1 Study Commission." 2 3 4 BE IT ENACTED by the Senate and General Assembly of the State 5 of New Jersey: 6 1. a. There is established ⁵<u>in the Board of Public Utilities</u>⁵ the 7 "²[Community]² Broadband ²<u>Access</u>² Study Commission." The 8 commission shall consist of ²[11] ⁴[12²] ⁵[13⁴] 19⁵ members as 9 10 follows: (1) the President of the Board of Public Utilities, ex officio, or 11 the president's designee, who shall serve as chairperson of the 12 13 commission; 14 (2) the Chief Technology Officer of the Office of Information Technology, ex officio, or the officer's designee; 15 16 (3) the Director of the Division of Rate Counsel, ex officio, or 17 the director's designee; (4) ²the Secretary of the Department of Agriculture, ex officio, 18 or the secretary's designee; 19 ⁵(5) the Chief Executive Officer of the New Jersey Economic 20 Development Authority, ex officio, or the officer's designee; 21 22 (6) the Commissioner of the Department of Education, ex officio, or the commissioner's designee; 23 24 (7) the Commissioner of the Department of Community Affairs, 25 ex officio, or the commissioner's designee; 26 (8) three public members to be appointed by the Governor, who shall have expertise in community broadband networks and 27 infrastructure; 28 $[(5)^2]$ (9)⁵ [two members] <u>one member</u>¹ of the Senate to be 29 appointed by the ⁵Governor, upon the recommendation of the⁵ 30 President of the Senate ¹[, which members shall not be of the same 31 political party]¹; 32 ${}^{2}[(5)] {}^{5}[(6)^{2}] (10)^{5} {}^{1}[two members] one member^{1} of the$ 33 General Assembly to be appointed by the ⁵Governor, upon the 34 recommendation of the⁵ Speaker of the General Assembly ¹[, 35 which members shall not be of the same political party]¹; 36 ${}^{2}[(6)] {}^{5}[(7)^{2}] (11)^{5} {}^{1}[two] three^{1}$ public members to be 37 appointed by ⁵the Governor, upon recommendation by⁵ the 38 President of the Senate, who shall include an individual with 39 EXPLANATION – Matter enclosed in bold-faced brackets [thus] in the above bill is not enacted and is intended to be omitted in the law. 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1 expertise in community broadband networks and infrastructure and 2 an individual with expertise in municipal and county governance or public utilities ¹, with one individual residing in the northern region 3 of the State, one individual residing in the central region of the 4 5 State, and one individual residing in the southern region of the State¹; ⁴[and]⁴ 6 ${}^{2}[(7)] {}^{5}[(8)^{2}] (12)^{5} {}^{1}[two] three^{1}$ public members to be 7 appointed by ⁵the Governor, upon recommendation by⁵ the Speaker 8 of the General Assembly, who shall include at least one individual 9 10 with expertise in community broadband networks and infrastructure and an individual with expertise in municipal and county 11 governance or public utilities ¹, with one individual residing in the 12 northern region of the State, one individual residing in the central 13 14 region of the State, and one individual residing in the southern region of the State^{1 4}; and 15 [(9)] (13) a member representing the New Jersey Library 16 Association to be appointed by the ⁵Governor, upon the 17 recommendation of the⁵ association's executive board⁴. 18 b. Any vacancy in the membership of the commission shall be 19 filled in the same manner in which the original appointment was 20 21 made. 22 c. Members of the commission shall serve without compensation but shall be reimbursed for necessary and reasonable expenses 23 24 incurred in the performance of their duties pursuant to this act 25 within the limits of funds appropriated or otherwise made available 26 to the commission for its purposes. d. For the purpose of this act $^{2}[,]$: 27 28 "broadband network" means a state-of-the-art network capable of 29 delivering download and upload speeds of no less than the standards 30 as defined by the Federal Communications Commission. The actual 31 speeds must be adjusted upwards to allow for improved technologies and usage requirements as determined by the 32 33 commission. 34 "broadband service" means any telecommunications service 35 using a broadband network for the purpose of offering high speed, 36 switched, broadband wireline telecommunications capability that 37 enables users to originate and receive high-quality voice, data, 38 graphics, or video telecommunications through the Internet and 39 using any technology.² 40 "community broadband network" means a local shared network 41 consisting of a series of interlinked computers that allow persons 42 with devices connected to a wired network within the area served to 43 gain entry to the wider Internet through high speed Internet service 44 connections at designated access points. 45 46 2. The commission shall organize as soon as possible after the 47 appointment of a majority of the commission's members and shall

meet at the call of the chairperson at the times and in the places it

may deem appropriate and necessary to fulfill its duties.

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3. ²a. The commission shall evaluate the impediments of access 3 to broadband service for all residents of New Jersey. The 4 5 commission shall look at issues, including but not limited to, physical access, deployment, and affordability of broadband 6 7 service. \underline{b}^{2} The commission shall evaluate the feasibility of establishing 8 community broadband networks in this State ²pursuant to the goals 9 of this act². The commission shall be responsible for, but not be 10 limited to, the following: 11 ²[a.] $(1)^{2}$ considering whether leasing or purchasing established 12 broadband infrastructure, such as ³, but not limited to, ³ unused fiber 13 optic cable ³and unused broadcast television signal space³, is more 14 advantageous in ²[creating a faster network] <u>achieving the goals</u> 15 pursuant to this act;² 16 ²[b.] (2)² considering whether establishing a community 17 broadband municipal or county agency or a non-profit corporation 18 is more appropriate to administer ²[the community] \underline{a}^2 broadband 19 20 network; ²[c.] $(3)^2$ evaluating the different methods, including legislation 21 and contracts with private companies, that other municipalities or 22 23 counties in this country have used to implement community 24 broadband networks; ²[d.] $(4)^{2}$ determining the most cost effective method in which 25 to establish community broadband networks, with a cost estimate 26 27 for the local government and a rate estimate for paying customers; 28 and 29 ²[e.] $(5)^2$ exploring all possible federal, State, and private funding sources for the establishment of community broadband 30 networks in this State. 31 32 33 4. The commission shall be entitled to call to its assistance and 34 avail itself of the services of the officials and employees of the State and its political subdivisions and their departments, boards, 35 bureaus, commissions, and agencies as it may require and as may be 36 available to it for the purposes of the commission. The Board of 37 38 Public Utilities shall provide staff support services to the 39 commission. 40 41 5. The commission shall report its findings, conclusions, and 42 recommendations to the Governor and, pursuant to section 2 of P.L.1991, c.164 (C.52:14-19.1), to the Legislature no later than one 43 44 year following the first meeting of the commission. The 45 commission shall expire upon the submission of the commission's 46 report, pursuant to this section.

the submission by the commission of its report pursuant to section 5
