1 **AN ACT** concerning means of communication with guardians of
2 veterans residing in Department of Military and Veterans’
3 Affairs memorial homes and supplementing P.L.1993, c.281
4 (C.38A:3-2b2 et seq.).

6 **BE IT ENACTED** *by the Senate and General Assembly of the State*
7 *of New Jersey:*

9 1. The Division of Veterans’ ¹**【Administrative】 Healthcare**
10 Services in the Department of Military and Veterans’ Affairs shall
11 ensure that each veterans’ memorial home shall communicate
12 updates to each veteran’s guardian appointed pursuant to section 1
13 of P.L.1993, c.281 (C.38A:3-2b2 et seq.), and each person
14 otherwise having the veteran’s power of attorney, through a
15 minimum of two communication means, which shall include regular
16 mail, email, text message, and voice.

18 2. This act shall take effect immediately.

23 Requires DMVA veterans’ memorial homes to communicate
24 with veterans’ guardians via at least two communication means.
