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9 1. (New section) a. As a condition of serving as a member of 10 the governing board of a public institution of higher education, a 11 person shall be required to complete a training program developed 12 <sup>1</sup>[or approved]<sup>1</sup> by <sup>1</sup>that institution in consultation with<sup>1</sup> the 13 Secretary of Higher Education that is designed to clarify the roles 14 and duties of a governing board member.

b. The training shall be completed no later than <sup>1</sup>[six months] <u>one year</u><sup>1</sup> after the date that the person is appointed as a member of the governing board of a public institution of higher education; except that a person who serves as a member of a governing board prior to the effective date of this act shall <sup>1</sup>[complete the training no later than six months after the effective date] <u>not be required to</u> <u>complete the training</u><sup>1</sup>.

The <sup>1</sup>institution, in consultation with the<sup>1</sup> secretary<sup>1</sup>, <sup>1</sup> shall: 22 c. (1) prescribe the subject matter of the training which shall 23 24 include, but need not be limited to, governance responsibilities, ethical standards, due diligence, the requirements of the "Senator 25 26 Byron M.
