1 AN ASSEMBLY RESOLUTION respectfully urging Congress to pass the federal "Community Parks Revitalization Act." 2 3 WHEREAS, The federal "Community Parks Revitalization Act," 4 most recently introduced in the United States House of 5 Representatives as ¹[H.R. 343] <u>H.R. 159</u>¹ on ¹[January 5, 2017] 6 January 4, 2021¹, would require the Secretary of Housing and 7 Urban Development (HUD) to carry out a community 8 9 revitalization program consisting of federal grants to eligible 10 local governments; and WHEREAS, Any applicant for a grant under the "Community Parks 11 12 Revitalization Act" would be required to submit to the HUD 13 Secretary evidence of its commitment to ongoing planning, 14 rehabilitation, service, operation, and maintenance programs for 15 its park and recreation systems; and WHEREAS, The legislation includes a safeguard provision to 16 17 prevent the misuse of funds by prohibiting conversion, without 18 HUD approval, of any property improved or developed with 19 assistance provided pursuant to the "Community Parks 20 Revitalization Act," for uses other than for public recreation; and WHEREAS, The legislation provides the HUD Secretary with 21 discretion to award such grants to certain communities which are 22 23 in need but do not technically meet the criteria to be awarded a 24 grant under the proposed program; and 25 WHEREAS, Public parks and recreation areas are vital to the 26 development and maintenance of municipalities throughout the 27 State, though State funding is limited with respect to creating 28 and maintaining public recreational areas; and 29 WHEREAS, Congress is urged to enact the "Community Parks Revitalization Act," or substantially similar legislation, in order 30 31 provide federal grant opportunities to New Jersey to 32 communities that are in need of new or updated public recreation areas; now, therefore, 33 34 35 BE IT RESOLVED by the General Assembly of the State of New 36 Jersey: 37 1. The General Assembly respectfully urges Congress to pass 38 the "Community Parks Revitalization Act," most recently 39 introduced in the United States House of Representatives as 40 41 ¹[H.R. 343] <u>H.R.159</u>¹, or substantially similar legislation, in order 42 to provide federal grant opportunities to New Jersey communities that are in need of new or updated public recreation areas. 43 44 45 2.
