## SYNOPSIS

Requires certain insurers to disclose whether business interruption insurance policy provides pandemic coverage.

1 AN ACT concerning business interruption insurance and 2 supplementing Title 17 of the Revised Statutes. 3 4 **BE IT ENACTED** by the Senate and General Assembly of the State 5 of New Jersey: 6 7 1. An insurer shall disclose, in a form and manner prescribed 8 by the Commissioner of Banking and Insurance, to any potential 9 purchaser of or any policyholder seeking renewal of a policy 10 insuring against loss or damage to property that includes the loss of 11 use and occupancy and business interruption in this State whether 12 the policy provides coverage for global virus transmission or pandemic coverage. 13 14 15 2. An insurer that has issued a policy insuring against loss or 16 damage to property that includes the loss of use and occupancy and 17 business interruption in this State that is in effect as of the date of 18 enactment of this act, shall notify the policyholder within 30 days of 19 the date of enactment of this act, through a written statement 20 delivered by mail or electronic means, of whether the policy 21 provides coverage for global virus transmission or pandemic 22 coverage. 23 24 3. Section 1 of this act shall take effect on the 30th day next 25 following the date of enactment, except that the commissioner shall 26 establish the form and manner for disclosure prior to that date. Section 2 shall take effect immediately. 27 28 29 30 **STATEMENT** 31 This bill requires insurers that issue policies of business 32 33 interruption in New Jersey to disclose to any potential purchaser or 34 policyholder seeking renewal whether the policy provides coverage 35 for global virus transmission or pandemic coverage. The disclosure to potential purchasers of business interruption insurance shall be in 36 37 a form and manner prescribed by the Commissioner of Banking and 38 Insurance. 39 The bill also requires insurers issuing business interruption 40 insurance in New Jersey to notify the policyholder, within 30 days 41 of the date of enactment of the bill, of whether the policy provides 42 coverage for global virus transmission or pandemic coverage. The 43 notification of policyholders of business interruption insurance is to 44 be in a written statement delivered by mail or electronic means.
