Permits exemption from civil service law enforcement examination requirement for county correctional police officers; permits hiring of such officers.

A municipal or county police department may hire a person, exempt from the requirement to take an examination for an entry-level law enforcement position pursuant to subsection a. of this section, upon adoption of an ordinance or resolution by the governing body authorizing such hiring by the police department and the adoption of a conflict of interest and nepotism policy.
- d. A county correctional facility may hire a person, exempt from the requirement to take an examination for an entry-level county correctional police officer position pursuant to subsection a. of this section, upon adoption of a resolution by the governing body authorizing such hiring by the correctional facility and the adoption of a conflict of interest and nepotism policy.

2. This act shall take effect six months following enactment, except the Civil Service Commission may take any anticipatory administrative action in advance as shall be necessary for the implementation of this act.

#### **STATEMENT**

Under current law, a person must pass the civil service examination prior to becoming eligible for employment as an entrylevel county correctional police officer.

EXPLANATION – Matter enclosed in bold-faced brackets [thus] in the above bill is not enacted and is intended to be omitted in the law.

Matter underlined thus is new matter.

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1 Under this bill, the Civil Service Commission will exempt from 2 the examination any person for an entry-level county correctional 3 police officer position who has successfully completed a full Basic 4 Course for Police Officers training course at a school approved and 5 authorized by the New Jersey Police Training commission. 6 Also, the bill permits a county correctional facility to hire a person 7 exempt from the requirement to take an examination for an entry-8 level position upon adoption of a resolution by the governing body 9 authorizing such hiring by the correctional facility and the adoption

of a conflict of interest and nepotism policy.

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
