The Civil Service Commission shall exempt from the 11 requirement to take an examination for an entry-level law 12 enforcement ¹officer¹ position¹, entry-level sherrif's officer 13 position,¹ or entry-level county correctional police officer position a 14 person who ¹[has]¹ successfully ¹[completed] <u>completes¹</u> a full 15 Basic Course for Police Officers training course ¹or a full Basic 16 Course for Correction Officers training course¹ at a school 17 approved and authorized by the New Jersey Police Training 18 19 commission ¹within nine months from the date of hire as a 20 provisional entry-level officer under the provisions of this section. (1) Any person employed under the provisions of this section 21 22 shall enroll in a training course approved by the New Jersey Police 23 Training Commission, and such person shall be entitled to a leave 24 of absence with pay during the period of the training course. 25 (2) Upon successful completion of the training course, any person employed under the provisions of this section shall be 26 27 promoted from a provisional entry-level law enforcement police officer, provisional entry-level sherrif's officer, or provisional 28 29 entry-level county correctional police officer to an entry-level law 30 enforcement officer, entry-level sheriff's officer, or entry-level 31 county correctional police officer, as appropriate¹. 32 ¹[The Civil Service Commission shall promulgate, pursuant b. 33 to the "Administrative Procedure Act," P.L.1968, c.410 (C.52:14B-1 et seq.), rules and regulations and establish administrative 34 35 processes that are reasonable, necessary, and consistent with the 36 provisions of this act.] (Deleted by amendment, P.L. , c.)
