SYNOPSIS

Allows certain voters residing overseas to vote in any election in this State regardless of duration of overseas residency or intent to return.

1 AN ACT concerning the right of certain voters residing overseas to 2 vote in New Jersey elections and amending P.L.1976, c.23. 3 4 **BE IT ENACTED** by the Senate and General Assembly of the State 5 of New Jersey: 6 7 1. Section 2 of P.L.1976, c.23 (C.19:59-2) is amended to read 8 as follows: 9 2. As used in this act: 10 "United States" means each of the several states, the District a. 11 of Columbia, Commonwealth of Puerto Rico, Guam, American 12 Samoa and the United States Virgin Islands; the term does not mean 13 or include the Canal Zone or any other territory or possession of the United States. 14 "Residing abroad" means residing outside the United States. 15 h 16 "Federal election" means any general, special or primary c. 17 held for the purpose of nominating or electing any candidate for the 18 office of President or Vice President of the United States, Presidential elector, United States Senator or member of the United 19 20 States House of Representatives. 21 d. "Election" shall have the same meaning as defined in 22 R.S.19:1-1, and include any federal, State, or local election, and any 23 public question placed before the voters. 24 e. "Overseas voter" means any person in military service, or 25 that person's spouse, partner in civil union, domestic partner, or 26 dependent, who, by reason of the person's active duty or service, is, 27 in the case of the person, absent on the date of an election from the 28 place of residence in New Jersey where the person is or would be 29 qualified to vote, or in the case of the person's spouse, partner in 30 civil union, domestic partner, or dependent, absent on the date of an 31 election from the place of residence in New Jersey where that spouse, partner in civil union, domestic partner, or dependent, is or 32 33 would be qualified to vote. 34 The term also means any citizen of the United States 35 [temporarily residing abroad] who (1) immediately prior to departure from the United States was domiciled in New Jersey and 36 37 (a) was last registered to vote, or last eligible to register and vote, in 38 New Jersey; or (b) would have been eligible to register and vote in 39 New Jersey except that the citizen had not attained 18 years of age 40 the requirement of which has since been met; or (c) would have 41 been eligible to register and vote in New Jersey except that the 42 citizen had not met the residency requirement; (2) is not registered 43 or qualified to vote elsewhere in the United States; and (3) holds a 44 valid passport or passport card or other proof of citizenship issued 45 under authority of the Secretary of State of the United States.

1 "Overseas federal election voter" means any citizen of the f. 2 United States residing abroad who does not intend to return or whose intent to return is uncertain and who (1) immediately prior to 3 4 departure from the United States was domiciled in New Jersey and 5 (a) was last registered to vote, or last eligible to register and vote, in 6 New Jersey; or (b) would have been eligible to register and vote in New Jersey except that the citizen had not attained 18 years of age 7 8 the requirement of which has since been met; or (c) would have 9 been eligible to register and vote in New Jersey except that the 10 citizen had not met the residency requirement; (2) is not registered 11 or qualified to vote elsewhere in the United States; and (3) holds a 12 valid passport or passport card or other proof of citizenship issued 13 under authority of the Secretary of State of the United States.

14 The term also means] any citizen of the United States who was 15 born outside of the United States, is not [described above] an 16 "overseas voter" under subsection e. of this section, and, except for 17 the residency requirement of New Jersey, otherwise satisfies the 18 State's voter eligibility requirements, if the last place where a 19 parent, legal guardian, spouse, partner in civil union, or domestic 20 partner of the voter was, or under P.L.1976, c.23 (C.19:59-1 et seq.) 21 would have been, eligible to register and vote before departure from 22 the United States is within New Jersey and the voter has not 23 previously registered to vote elsewhere in the United States.

24 "Electronic means" means any transmission made by an g. 25 electronic telefacsimile machine or a similar device or by any other 26 form of electronic transmission including, but not exclusive to 27 electronic mail, that transports an authentic copy of a document 28 from one user to another.

29 h. "Dependent" means an individual recognized as a dependent 30 by a military service.

31 i. "Federal postcard application" means the application 32 prescribed under section 101 of Pub.L.99-410 (42 U.S.C. 33 s.1973ff(b)(2)).

34 "Federal write-in absentee ballot" means the ballot described i. 35 under section 103 of Pub.L.99-410 (42 U.S.C. s.1973ff-2).

"Military service" means the active and reserve components 36 k. 37 of the Army, Navy, Air Force, Marine Corps, or Coast Guard of the 38 United States; the Merchant Marine; the commissioned corps of the 39 Public Health Service or the commissioned corps of the National 40 Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration of the United States; or the National Guard or State militia. 41

STATEMENT

3 Under current law, any citizen of the United States residing 4 abroad who does not intend to return or whose intent to return is 5 uncertain is permitted to vote in this State for federal elections only, 6 using an overseas ballot. uch "overseas federal election voter" is 7 permitted to vote if the voter (1) immediately prior to departure 8 from the United States was domiciled in New Jersey and (a) was 9 last registered to vote, or last eligible to register and vote, in New 10 Jersey; or (b) would have been eligible to register and vote in New 11 Jersey except that the citizen had not attained 18 years of age the 12 requirement of which has since been met; or (c) would have been 13 eligible to register and vote in New Jersey except that the citizen 14 had not met the residency requirement; (2) is not registered or 15 qualified to vote elsewhere in the United States; and (3) holds a 16 valid passport or passport card or other proof of citizenship issued 17 under authority of the Secretary of State of the United States.

18 This bill would remove these criteria from the definition of an 19 "overseas federal election voter." That term would now only apply 20 to any citizen of the United States who was born outside of the United States and, except for the requirement to have resided in 21 22 New Jersey, otherwise satisfies the State's voter eligibility 23 requirements, if the last place where a parent, legal guardian, 24 spouse, partner in civil union, or domestic partner of the voter was, 25 or under N.J.S.A.19:59-1 et seq. would have been, eligible to 26 register and vote before departure from the United States is within 27 New Jersey and the voter has not previously registered to vote 28 elsewhere in the United States. These voters would be eligible to 29 vote in New Jersey for federal elections only.

30 This bill would also remove the requirement for temporary 31 residence abroad from the definition of "overseas voter," thereby 32 allowing any person who meets the specified criteria to register to 33 vote and to apply for and vote by mail-in ballot in any election held 34 in the election district of this State in which the voter was formerly 35 domiciled immediately prior to departure from the United States. 36 These voters would be eligible to vote in any federal, State, or local 37 election, and any public question placed before the voters.
